Blue grama grass	Bouteloua gracilis
Perky Sue	Tetranneuris argentea
Threadleaf Woollywhite	Hymenopappus filifolius
Verbena, Dakota vervain	Glandularia bipinnatifida
Claret Cup cactus	Echinocereus triglochidiatus
Fleabane	Erigeron sp. (more than 15 species in New Mexico)
Prickly Pear	Opuntia sp. (at least five species with yellow blossoms in Santa Fe)
Wax Currant	Ribes cereum
One-seed Juniper	Juniperus monosperma
