- 10:30a-1:00p: Explore more NMCRR and Rail Trail (<15 miles, paved)

Saturday, Sept. 29

- 10:30a-1:00p: Explore more Chili Line, with La Tierra Trails & River Trail (<15 miles, dirt & paved, some hills)
