

Equipment List for Bears Ears Camping Trip

Tent (with a rain fly if possible) and stakes (we will bring hammers)

Sleeping Bag (nights can get down into the 40s)

Sleeping Mat/ Air Mattress

Pillow

Repair kits for tent and air mattress

Folding Chair

Sun Shielding Hat

Bandanas

Sunglasses

Sunscreen

Lip Balm

Bug Repellent (maybe won't need)

Head lamp/ Flash light – extra batteries

Pocket knife

Personal First aid kit

Toiletries – Biodegradable soap for hair and washing and bio toothpaste

Good broken-in hiking boots

Different shoes for around the camp

Jacket for cool evenings

Plenty of socks

Long sleeve shirt(s)

Good hiking pants

Rain suit (include pants) or poncho

Sturdy Day Pack – we will carry up to 20 pounds a day

Water bottles or bladder for your pack – **we will be carrying all our water**

PLEASE make sure you can carry enough water each day – I carry 3 liters

Personal cup, bowl, plate and silverware

Lunch container with LID to carry in day pack (a must)

Camera – extra batteries and plastic bag to protect camera from sand

Lightweight Binoculars – great for star gazing

Solar shower – for freshening up at the end of the day

Playing cards or other games to share
